POWERS TO AGNESS HIGHWAY NEWSLETTER **Progress Report**

Western Federal Lands Highway Division and Tidewater Contractors are starting to gear up for the upcoming 2012 construction season. This will be the second year of the two year Powers to Agness Highway project.



Last construction season highlights is the Hayes Creek Bridge and adjacent roadway reconstruction.

Tidewater Contractors plans on resuming work in the week starting on the 28th of May.

Construction Scheduled for the week of May 28, 2012

Work will begin with the installation of a culvert pipe located in the first realignment section and repair the settlement in the road where the culverts were installed last season. Tidewater Contractor's also plans starting construction on the reinforced soil slope on wall at Station 127+60 on Wednesday.

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Traffic Information

Expect 20 minute delays with the one lane road closures to repair the settlement over the pipes. Tuesday May 29th will begin the one lane closure for the reinforced soil slope wall between Stations 127+60 to 128+60. The one lane closure will be regulated with temporary traffic signals which will be installed on May 29th.
