Service Learning & Global Issues

As you begin your service learning project, focus on understanding the issue the project will address, and its relevance to your students and your curriculum.

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Pre-Service

Gather information about the global issue and develop a plan for a service project that addresses the issue. Investigate connections with curricular knowledge and skills.
