


Workshop Goals

- CAPTURE stakeholder feedback on targeted cross-cutting issues regarding data sharing and open source application development




Top 6 Voting Results All Data Environments





Top 6 Voting Results All Impact Areas








Top 6 Voting Results Appears Twice or More
