SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade Policy Memorandum <u>#13</u>, Suspension of Installation Driving Privileges for Excessive Speed

- 1. References:
 - a. AR 190-5, Motor Vehicle Traffic Supervision, 22 May 2006
 - b. AR 385-10, The Army Safety Program, 27 August 2007
- 2. Purpose: I am committed to providing a safe and secure environment to all individuals granted access to Fort George G. Meade. Recently, I have seen an alarming number of traffic cases involving individuals driving excess of 20 miles per hour over the posted speed limit. I am deeply concerned about this, as it directly impacts the safety of our personnel, Families, and visitors. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance on my standards for suspension.
- 3. Applicability: This policy is applicable to all individuals granted access to Fort George G. Meade, Maryland.
- 4. Policy: Drivers cited or ticketed for speeding more than 20 miles per hour over the posted speed limit may have their installation driving privileges suspended for a 30 day period. I intend to carefully review each of these cases and I will administratively suspend on post driving privileges when I determine that cause or a lawful reason exists. Restoration of driving privileges may occur on a case-by-case basis and will be in accordance with policies stated in AR 190-5, para 2-4.
