Subj: SINGLE MARINE PROGRAM ALCOHOL POLICY

Ref: (a) MCO 1700.22E

1. Situation. To establish guidelines for consumption of alcohol beverages and control measures for the Single Marine Program (SMP), transportation and trips. The Zone is an alcohol free facility.
2. Mission. To publish a policy and procedures for the consumption of alcohol during SMP trips.
3. Execution.
  - a. Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations
    - (1) Commander's Intent
      - (a) Commanders, Directors, and Trip Captains will ensure Alcohol Beverage Control reflects command presence and leadership initiatives.
    - (2) Concept of Operations
      - (a) Unauthorized Consumption. No alcohol is to be consumed by anyone under the age of 21. No alcohol is to be consumed in any vehicle used for transportation in conjunction with SMP Program.
      - (b) Authorized Consumption. If legal age, SMP participant may drink responsibly at the final destination of the SMP trip. Unless, the final destination is alcohol free. It is the responsibility of the Trip Captain to ensure that those who drink are of legal age per reference (a).
      - (c) Controls for Consumption. If an SMP participant provides alcohol to an underage participant, drinks underage, drinks excessively and not responsible will be reported to their Sergeant Major, for appropriate action. He/She will not be permitted to attend any further SMP trips or SMP events.
