Brett received both a B.S. and Masters degree in Mechanical Engineering from Cornell University before joining the laboratory as a technical staff member in 2002. While at Cornell, he was awarded a NASA grant to pursue work in autonomous robotics, culminating with international distinction awards in 2000 and 2002. At Los Alamos, his interests have included advanced sensing technologies with contributions to wireless sensing, ultrasonics, lamb wave propagation, fiber optics, and shock physics analysis. In 2005 he was awarded a distinguished performance award from the laboratory and a defense programs award of excellence from the Department of Energy for work in flight diagnostics. In the fall, Brett will attend the University of California at San Diego to complete a doctorate in controls and applied physics.
