This map shows all stations sampled for the purposes of reopening, surveillance (baseline), surveillance of closed areas, surveillance of the perimeter, and surveillance of reopened areas. The small gray dots show all stations sampled from April 28, 2010 through January 15, 2011. The larger blue dots represent surveillance of reopened areas sampled from March 6 – June 15, 2011, and the red dots are stations sampled for reopening the final closed area nearest the well. Sensory and chemistry results for seafood collected as part of reopening and surveillance of reopened areas (through January 15, 2011) in federal waters can be found here. Many of the samples collected for surveillance (baseline), surveillance closed and surveillance of the perimeter areas were collected when the oil spill area was expanding. Subsequent to the capping of the well, the priority for testing was changed to reopening, so these earlier surveillance samples were archived not tested.
