It will help fill a financing gap for SMEs in the host country market, since the current credit crisis has reduced the amount of liquidity available for equipment leasing. As the project will target the SME sector, it should result in downstream multiplier effects throughout the local economy. Docuformas's partnership with the Alta Group, an American leasing services consulting firm, will train the firm in the best global practices in the areas of lease underwriting, lease administration, collections, and compliance with international anti-money laundering procedures.
