Concrete Deck Placement

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

This week the contractor has completed the placement of approximately 140 feet of deck along the east end of the viaduct and one column was constructed on the north end of the viaduct.

Next week, the contractor will continue with the construction of falsework and formwork along the viaduct in preparation for future pours. In the coming weeks, the contractor plans to begin micropile construction. The first micropiles will be drilled along the interior curb beam, at each of the 29 interior columns.

DELAYS AND CLOSURES

The Historic Columbia River Highway is closed to all public traffic between Larch Mountain Road and Latourell Road until February 1, 2012.

Due to the closure, Crown Point and the Vista House are now inaccessible to the public, and are currently closed to the public.
