ONGOING EFFORTS

- 1. EPA CCR proposed rule to OMB on landfills and impoundments. EPA has published a proposed rule June 21, 2010 with two possible options, either under Subtitle C hazardous waste or Subtitle D solid waste. EPA is being sued by enviros and ash recyclers for lack of action. No news on when or what EPA will ultimately propose.
- 2. OSM CCR Rulemaking. The proposed rule and EA were submitted for solicitor review in mid February. Publication of a proposed rule is scheduled for November 2012.
- **3. OSM Stream Protection Rulemaking** OSM is internally reviewing the proposed rule and is writing the EIS. **Publication of the proposed rule is scheduled for November 2012.**
- **4. Indiana Bat Guidance Document Survey.** A survey was sent to the FWS, OSM, states, and industry to assess how the guidance document was working. The survey results have been completed and the original guidance document development team has been re-activated to determine if changes need to be made. The current schedule is to have any changes implemented by September of 2012.
