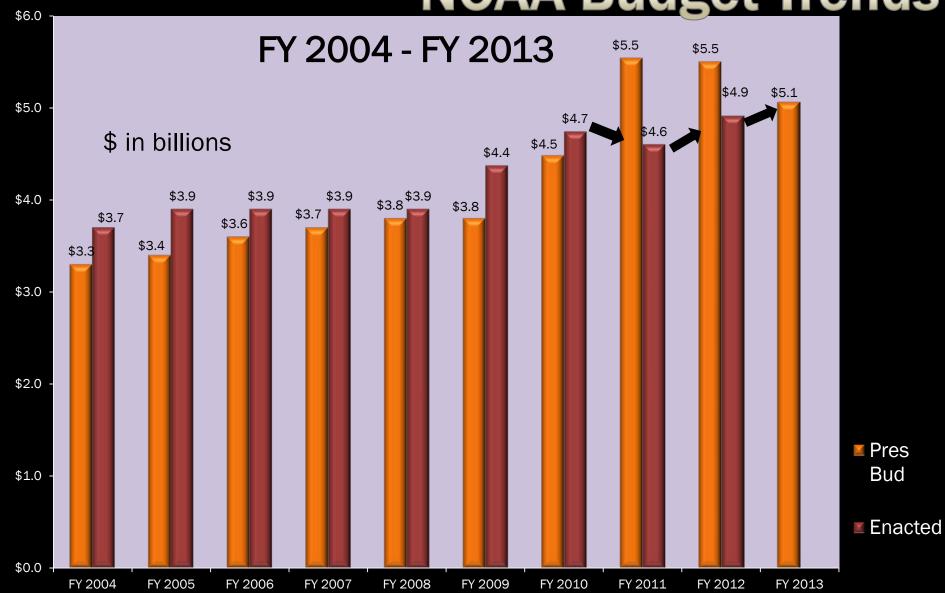
FY 2013 Budget Overview

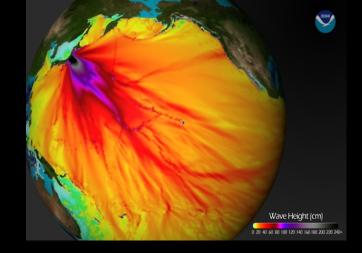

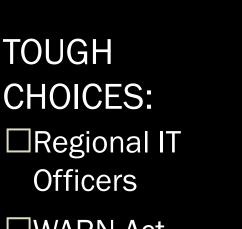

ADMINISTRATIVE SAVINGS

FY 2013 BUDGET INCLUDES AN ADDITIONAL \$16M IN ADMINISTRATIVE COST REDUCTIONS FOR NOAA

The Administration is continuing its pursuit to reduce administrative spending while sustaining our critical oversight functions. The Department's total savings target for FY 2013 is \$176 million, which includes \$142.8 million in savings initiated in FY 2012 and an additional \$33.2 million planned for FY 2013.
