Army Family Covenant Benefits



IF YOUR STATUS IS:	YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR:
ALL PATRONS	1- Free CYS registration and Re-registration fees
	2- Free hourly group care for all attendees of a memorial service for a Fallen Soldier
Mission Level 1 -	1- Free hourly or Kids on Site (KOS) care during mandatory deployment meetings
Deployed	2- Free hourly or KOS care for FRG meetings (paid thru ACS)
	3- 16 hours free hourly Respite Care (per child/month) starts 30 days before deploy to 90 days after return
	4- \$2.00 per child per hour rate for any hourly care beyond the free Respite care hours
	5- Free hourly care for Support group meetings during AW2, WT, SOS period
	6- 20% reduction to fees for reg scheduled full/part day care. Valid 30 days before deploy to 90 days after return
	7- Up to \$300 for SKIES classes per deployment per child/youth
	8- Up to \$100 for CYSS Team or individual sports per deployment per child/youth
Mission Level 2 -	1- Free hourly or Kids on Site (KOS) care during mandatory deployment meetings
TCS,	2- Free hourly or KOS care for FRG meetings (3 hrs per child per month)
PCS Unaccomp,	3- 16 hours free hourly Respite Care (per child, per month) during designated TCS, PCS, or TDY period
TDY (90-179) days	4- \$2.00 per child per hour rate for any hourly care beyond the free Respite care hours
	5- Up to \$150 for SKIES classes per child/youth during designated support assignment
	6- Up to \$50 for CYSS Team or individual sports per child/youth during designated support assignment
Mission Level 3	1- Free hourly or Kids on Site (KOS) care during mandatory deployment meetings
Rear Det Cadre,	2- Free hourly or KOS care for FRG meetings (paid thru ACS)
Warriors in Transition	
(WT Cadre)	4- \$2.00 per child per hour rate for any hourly care beyond the free Respite care hours
	5- Up to \$150 for SKIES classes per child/youth during designated support assignment
	6- Up to \$50 for CYSS Team or individual sports per child/youth during designated support assignment
