There were no reports of serious property damage or injuries. **Kauai County** 0003HST 0004HST 0 0 Anahola 04 Lightning A civil defense official informed the National Weather Service office in Lihue, Kauai, that a lightning strike had started a fire at an Anahola residence. However, no damage estimates were available on the blaze. **Kauai County** 20 E Lihue 04 Lightning Lightning struck a Boeing 727 aircraft as it was flying east of Lihue. Damage estimates were not available, however **Honolulu County** Ewa Beach 04 Lightning A lightning strike damaged a home in Ewa Beach on Oahu, and cut the power for several hours. No damage estimates were available. **Honolulu County** Kahana to 06 1355HST 0 **Heavy Rain** Pacific Palisades 1730HST Heavy showers and thunderstorms brought small stream and drainage ditch flooding, and ponding of roadways to windward and central areas of Oahu. However, no serious injuries or property damage were reported. **Honolulu County** Kaneohe to 07 **Heavy Rain** Makakilo City Heavy showers produced ponding of roadways, and small stream and drainage ditch flooding in southeastern, southern, and leeward sections of Oahu. No serious property damage or injuries were reported. Kauai County Wailua to 07 0 **Heavy Rain** Heavy rain and showers produced small stream and drainage ditch flooding, and ponding of roadways in eastern and southern parts of Kauai. There were no reports of serious injuries or property damage, however. Hawaii County Kailua Kona to 09 1815HST 0 **Heavy Rain** Kealakekua

Heavy showers over the lower mountain slopes and along coastal areas of leeward parts of the Big Island, in the North Kona District, caused ponding of roadways, and small stream and drainage ditch flooding. There were no reports of serious injuries or property damage.
