Wildfire 0 1 Six wildfires blackened about 3000 acres of mostly brush land in inaccessible parts of western and central Molokai. However, one

of the blazes did briefly threaten homes in Maunaloa and forced the temporary evacuation of Molokai Ranch campsites. No other homes or structures were threatened by the fires. A helicopter, one of three helping to fight the fires, crashed about 1315 on the 26th of June. The pilot of the aircraft sustained injuries, but they were not life-threatening. Firefighters from Molokai and Maui battled the fires; along with Molokai Ranch crews that used heavy equipment to make fire breaks. The causes of the blazes were unknown, though a fire official said they were suspicious in nature.
