The funnel cloud was initially stationary, then moved slowly toward the southeast before dissipating. **Honolulu County** Nanakuli 13 1810HST 0 0 **Funnel Cloud** A nearly stationary funnel cloud was observed from Nanakuli. **Maui County** 15 SE Hana 14 1610HST Waterspout Two stationary waterspouts were observed over the Alenuihaha Channel. **Honolulu County** Waianae 15 1230HST 1400HST 0 Flash Flood Significant road and stream flooding occurred from heavy showers and thunderstorms in the Makakilo and Nanakuli areas. Water to 4 feet deep flooded parts of the Farrington Highway in Nanakuli. A WSR-88D rainfall estimate of 6 inches per hour was corroborated by a weather spotter in Makakilo who measured 5.8 inches during the same time period **Honolulu County** Makakilo City 15 1240HST 0 **Funnel Cloud** 0 A nearly stationary funnel cloud was observed from Makakilo **Honolulu County** Nanakuli 15 1300HST 1 Lightning A 45 year-old man was struck by lightning while leaning against a chain-link fence at his residence at 89-155 Nanaikala Place in Nanakuli. The man was hospitalized and observed for several hours and then released. **Maui County** Urban/Sml Stream Fld Pukalani to 15 1530HST Haiku Minor road and stream flooding reported throughout the area from Pukalani to Makawao to Haiku. **Honolulu County** Pearl City to Halawa Heights 1700HST 2030HST Urban/Sml Stream Fld 15 Small streams, streets and drainage ditches were flooded, including parts of the Moanalua Freeway. **Kauai County** Hanalei to 2130HST 0500HST Urban/Sml Stream Fld Minor street and stream flooding along the north and east sides of the island, including the towns of Wainiha, Hanalei, Kapaa, Wailua, and Lihue. **Hawaii County** Honaunau 1700HST 2015HST 0 Urban/Sml Stream Fld 16 Minor street flooding and small landslides occurred in the Honaunau area. **Honolulu County** Honolulu 0 Urban/Sml Stream Fld 17 1500HST

An upper level low from northwest of the Hawaiian Islands cut-off just north of the state and persisted in the area from the 15th through the 17th. During this period, moisture from the remnants of Tropical Cyclone Guillermo combined with an unstable airmass due to the close proximity of the upper level low to help fuel widely scattered heavy showers and thunderstorms over all of the islands.
