No serious injuries or property damage were reported. **Maui County** Hana 26 2130HST 2359HST 0 Urban/Sml Stream Fld Heavy rainfall produced minor stream flooding and ponding of roadways in and near the town of Hana in East Maui. There were no reports of property damage or serious injuries. **Hawaii County** 0 Flood **West Portion** 27 Frequent showers caused heavy soil runoff and mudslides near Waikoloa village, along with minor stream flooding and ponding of roadways. No serious injuries or property damage were reported, however. **Maui County** Pauwela to Hana 28 0 Flash Flood Strong thunderstorms along the northeast-facing slopes of Haleakala in East Maui caused heavy runoff that affected the Hana

Kailua and Nahiku.
