Hawaii County 8 SE Milolii 18 2000HST Lightning A 40-year old male was injured slightly by a lightning strike while touching a knob on his amateur radio. The person experienced numbness between his knee and ankle on the same side as the hand touching the radio knob. **Hawaii County** Hawaii 2100HST 0200HST Urban/Sml Stream Fld Scattered heavy showers caused widespread minor flooding of streets and low-lying areas in the lower elevations of the North and South Kohala, North and South Kona, Kau, Puna, and North and South Hilo districts. **Hawaii County** Milolii 18 2100HST 0 Hail(0.75) Nickel-size hail was reported near this South Kona community. **Hawaii County** 8 SE Milolii Hail(0.75) Nickel-size hail reported near Hawaiian Ocean View Estates in Kau District. **Hawaii County** Kealakekua 2100HST Lightning struck a cable in a housing complex for the elderly, damaging television sets in three separate residences. **Hawaii County** 8 SE Milolii 18 2200HST 0 0 Lightning
