## **EXCHANGE VISITOR PROGRAM (J-VISA) REGULATIONS**

Regulations governing the Exchange Visitor Program are located in Title 22 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 62. These regulations implement the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act of 1961, as amended, (Public Law 87-256) and are applicable to all sponsors. A sponsor must ensure that all employees, officers, agents, and third parties involved in the administration of their exchange visitor program are adequately qualified, appropriately trained, and comply with the Exchange Visitor Program regulations. A periodic review of the regulations will help remind sponsors, responsible officers (ROs) and alternate responsible officers (AROs) of their responsibilities.
