Rules

- Please bring your own bags. The money we save on purchasing paper bags is used to bring more food and hygiene products to you each month. Those who bring their own bag will receive an extra product during the distribution.
- **DO NOT arrive before 1330** as we need space to set up and we cannot interfere with traffic in and out of the community center if you are waiting in the parking lot prior to 1330 you will be asked to leave)
- Please do not drive more than 15 miles to attend you will be spending more on gas than the value of the product given out
- There is NO "saving spots" for others in line it is not fair to those who have been waiting.
- If your family is caught being dishonest or "cheating" you will not be allowed to return (examples include, but are not limited to: two people in the same household signing up separately, cutting in line with someone else, taking extra product).
- Please be mindful of your children.
