Our Goal

Our goal is to provide you with the best program possible. By doing so, we will provide your children with age-appropriate, educational and recreational activities that reflect the interests of the youth.

Thus encouraging creativity, positive self image, character building, and teamwork, in the safest and most convenient manner possible.







Eligibility

Children who have completed 1st grade (with proof of report card) through those who have completed 8th grade (with proof of report card) will be eligible to participate in the summer camp program. A child eligible to participate must be a dependent of active duty military and/or DoD civilians and Arsenal approved contractors employed at the Watervliet Arsenal. First priority is to active duty and/or DoD civilian personnel who are either single parents, or whose spouse is on active duty, attends school on a full or part-time basis or is employed.

Fees

Fees are based on a sliding scale of the total family income and are calculated utilizing patron LES/pay stubs. There is a 15% reduction in fees for more than one child enrolled in the summer camp program.



Daily Activities

Our program provides age-appropriate, theme-based activities such as arts and



crafts, swimming, various outdoor sports, games and lessons, as well as community service projects. During the summer we host Carnival Days with a bouncy-bounce waterslide (above right) and prizes!

Field Trips

Your child will love the variety of field trips we offer! We attend one to two field trips per week. In the past we have visited Great Escape, Million Dollar Beach, The Fun Spot, an IMAX 3D movie and a ValleyCats baseball game, among many other fun, exciting and educational places!
