The Committee on Energy and Commerce conducted the following hearings and meetings during the month of July 2009:

Thursday, July 16, 17, 20, 30, and 31, 2009 – The Committee met in open **markup** session and considered **H.R. 3200**, the America's Affordable Health Choices Act of 2009. H.R. 3200 was ordered favorably reported to the House, amended, by a roll call vote of 31 – 28 on July 31, 2009.

THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND COMMERCE ALSO OCCURRED DURING THE MONTH OF JULY 2009:

Wednesday, July 29, 2009 – The Committee on Energy and Commerce filed the House report on **H.R. 2749**, the “Food Safety Enhancement Act of 2009”, (House Report 111-234).

Wednesday, July 29, 2009 – The House considered **H.R. 2749** under suspension of the rules, as amended, which failed by a vote of 280 – 150 (2/3 voting in the majority required to pass).

Thursday, July 30, 2009 – The House considered **H.R. 2749**, the Food Safety Enhancement Act of 2009, as amended, under a rule and passed by a vote of 283 – 142.
