

Bio for CSM Jeffery L. McClure

Command Sergeant Major Jeffery L. McClure was born 30 November 1963 in Nuremburg, Germany. Command Sergeant Major McClure began his military career in 1983 as an Advanced Rifle Marksmanship Instructor with USAR. In 1985 Command Sergeant Major McClure joined the Oregon Army National Guard as a Cavalry Scout. Command Sergeant Major McClure served in there in a variety of assignments, culminating in his assignment as a Flight Operations Specialist, until 1988, when he joined the active component as a mechanized infantryman. Command Sergeant Major McClure returned to Aviation in 1993 with a Medical Evacuation (Air Ambulance) Detachment at the Joint Readiness Training Center. In September of 1995, Command Sergeant Major McClure rejoined the Oregon Army National Guard and entered service into the Title 10 AGR program.

Command Sergeant Major McClure has served as a Noncommissioned Officer in Charge at every level from fire team leader to Brigade CSM, including staff assignments at the 4 star level. His AGR assignments include: 2 Regional Flight Centers (Fort Leavenworth, Kansas and Howard Air Force Base, Panama); Joint Operational Support Airlift Center, Scott Air Force Base, Illinois; S3 Noncommissioned Officer in Charge, OSAA; Senior Enlisted Advisor, United States Army South (Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico); G3 Operations SGM, Fifth United States Army, Fort Sam Houston, Texas; Mobilized and deployed as an Embedded Training Team Brigade Command Sergeant Major (Zabul Province, Islamic Republic of Afghanistan); Senior Enlisted Advisor, Reserve Component Training Integration Directorate (RCTID), Headquarters TRADOC; Deployed as the Operations Sergeant Major for all Agri-Business Development Teams (ADT) with CJTF-101/82, Islamic Republic of Afghanistan. After his second Afghan deployment, Command Sergeant Major McClure served as the Sergeant Major for the National Guard Bureau's Aviation and Safety Division. CSM McClure has served as the Command Sergeant Major for the Operational Support Airlift Command for the past 2 ½ years. He has 4 combat deployments, including: Panama, Persian Gulf and his 2 deployments to Afghanistan.

Command Sergeant Major McClure's military training includes: MOS's 11Z and 15Z, the Primary Leadership Development Course, Basic Noncommissioned Officer Course, Advanced Noncommissioned Officer Course, Sergeant's Major Academy (NRC) Class 29, Battle Staff Noncommissioned Officer Course, Air Assault Course, Unit Armorer's Course, Training and Mobilization Course, Readiness NCO Course and the Aviation Accident Prevention Course.

Command Sergeant Major McClure's awards and decorations include: Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (2 OLC), Army Commendation Medal (3 OLC), Joint Service Achievement Medal (1 OLC), Army Achievement Medal (2 OLC), Good Conduct Medal (6th Award), Armed Forces Reserve Medal with silver hourglass and M devices, Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, NATO Non-Article 5 Medal (1 OLC), Air Assault Badge, Senior Aviation Badge, and the Combat Infantryman's Badge.
