

Rules for visiting the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station

All Foreign Visitors who possess a DoD Common Access Card (CAC) or DD Form 1173 series, Dependent Identification and Privilege Card requesting access to Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station (NFARS) base lodging facilities, must submit their requests no later than 15 working days prior to the visit start date. Those requests not submitted in a timely manner may be disapproved for administrative purposes and will be handled on case by case bases.

All foreign visitors without a DoD CAC or DD Form 1173 Dependent Identification and Privilege Card, who request access to the installation, must be sponsored by an individual who has sponsor/escort authority.

Who can sponsor a guest? Anyone possessing the following credentials may be a sponsor/escort:

1. A person in possession of a Department of Defense Common Access Card (CAC)
2. A person in possession of a DD Form 1173 which is a Dependent Identification Privilege Card
3. A person in possession of a DD Form 2 Retired Military Identification

Roles and Duties of a sponsor/escort?

1. Sponsors must meet their guests at the Security Forces Visitor Center during the hours of 0730-1600 on M-F. After hours and on weekends/holidays, sponsors must meet their guests at the Lockport Gate.
2. Sponsors will be responsible for their guests during their entire stay on NFARS
