| | | Class A |
| | | - Combination vehicle with a gross combination weight rating (GCWR) of 26,001 lbs. or more |
| | | - Towing vehicle with a GVWR 10,000 pounds or more |
| | | Class B |
| | | - Single unit vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 26,001 lbs. or more |
| | | - Any such vehicle towing a vehicle not in excess of 10,000 lbs. GVWR. |
| | | Class C |
| | | - Any vehicle transporting hazardous material in any amount requiring the display of placards. |
| | | - Any vehicle designed to transport 16 passengers or more, including the driver. |
| 5. | Canadian CDL | Canada does not issue a separate commercial license.Canadian drivers are issued a "Classified" driver's license which |

| | | defines what "class" of vehicle they can drive. |

| | | - Canadian driver's licenses are issued according to the type of vehicle to be driven. |
| | | - A driver's license must match the type of vehicle being driven. |
| | | - License class is usually identified by number, but may be identified by letter, as is done in Ontario. |
| | | - If you encounter a Canadian CDL and have questions, call a CMV certified inspector. |
| 6. | Canadian License | Important: Notice the spelling of License. In Canada: Licence. In the US: License. |
| 7. | Mexican CDL | - At this time there is a pilot program which allows Mexican CMVs to drive in the US. |
| | | - The Licencia Federal de Conductor is recognized by the US as comparable to a US issued CDL. |
| | | - Approved Mexican carriers and drivers are required to comply with U.S. laws and regulations. □- If you encounter a Mexican CMV and have questions, call a CMV certified inspector. |
