MEMORANDUM FOR Parks Reserve Forces Training Area Soldier's Families, DA Civilians, Contract Personnel, and Tenant Units

SUBJECT: PRFTA Policy # 17, Guidance for Subsisting in the Parks Reserve Forces Training Area and BT Collins Dining Facilities (DFAC's).

1. REFERENCES.

a. AR 30-22, The Army Food Program, 10 May 2005

b. Department of the Army Pamphlet, Operating Procedures for the Army Food Program, 6 February 2007

2. PURPOSE. To define personnel authorized to subsist in US Army Garrison Dining Facilities (DFAC) located at PRFTA and BT Collins.

3. APPLICABILITY. This policy is applicable to Military Dependents, DoD Civilians, Contractor Personnel (in possession of DoD CAC cards), and Tenant Units.

4. POLICY.

a. Effective 1 September 2011, DoD Civilians, and Contractors registered in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) working on the installation are authorized to use garrison dining facilities on an occasional basis.

b. PRFTA Emergency Services Personnel may subsist anytime when on duty. Authorized DOD Civilians and Contractor personnel are limited to the last half hour of the published meal serving period. When the projected headcount equals or exceeds the 90% seating capacity of the DFAC, a sign will be posted at the entrance, restricting access.

c. Immediate Family Members in possession of Permanent Change of Station (PCS) orders who are within 10 days of PCS may purchase meals regardless of these limitations.

5. PROCEDURES. All personnel will show a valid CAC card or dependent ID card with PCS orders. Non military personnel will purchase the meal and sign the DD Form 1544, Cash Meal Payment Sheet. Personnel in possession of PCS orders (4c) must show dependent ID card with PCS order.
