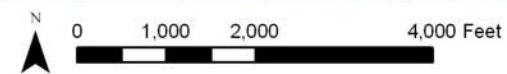
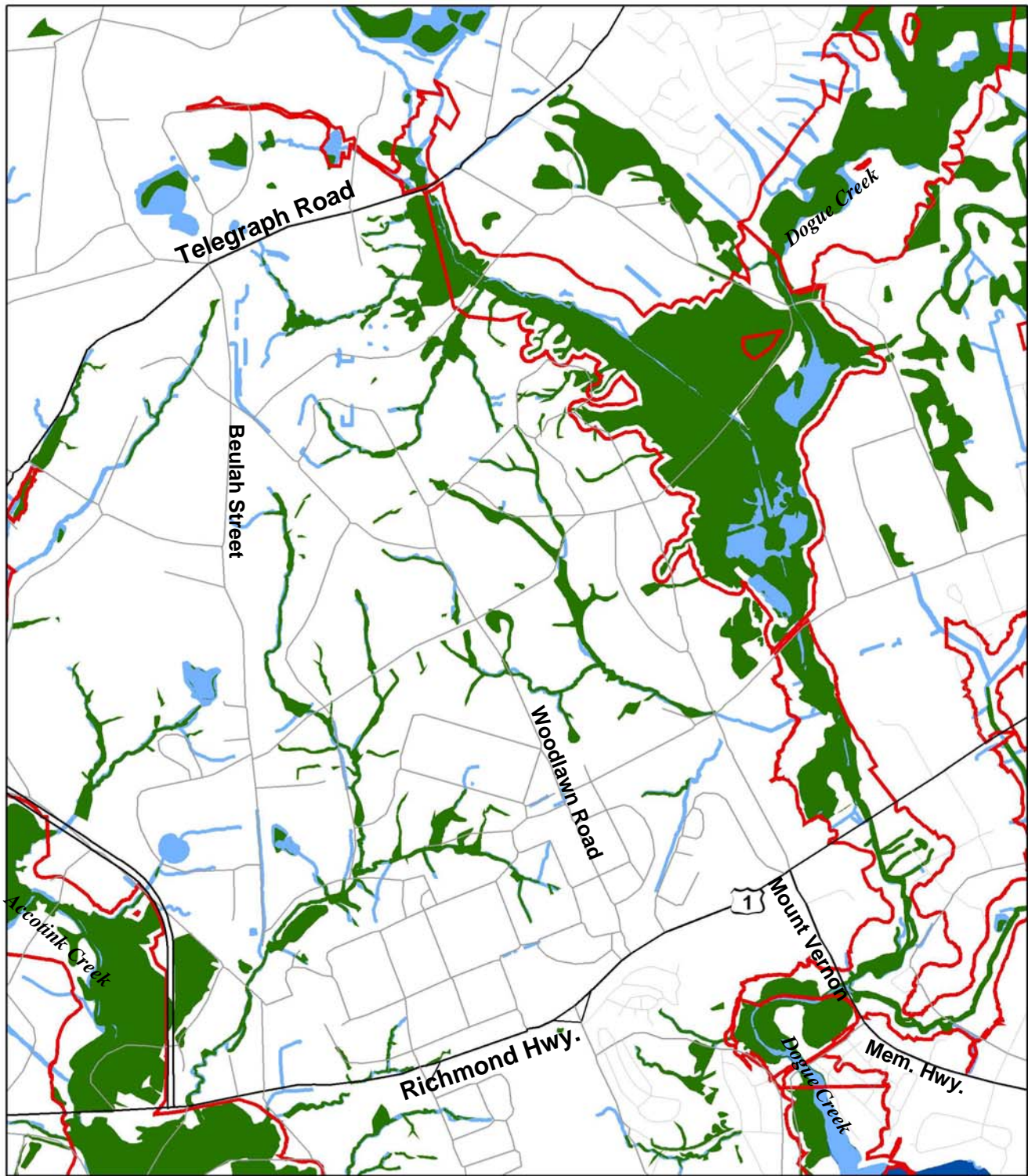

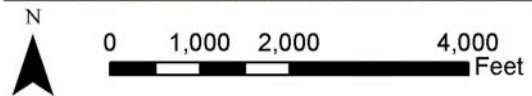

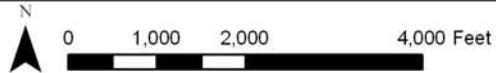

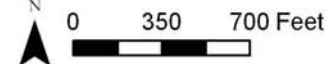

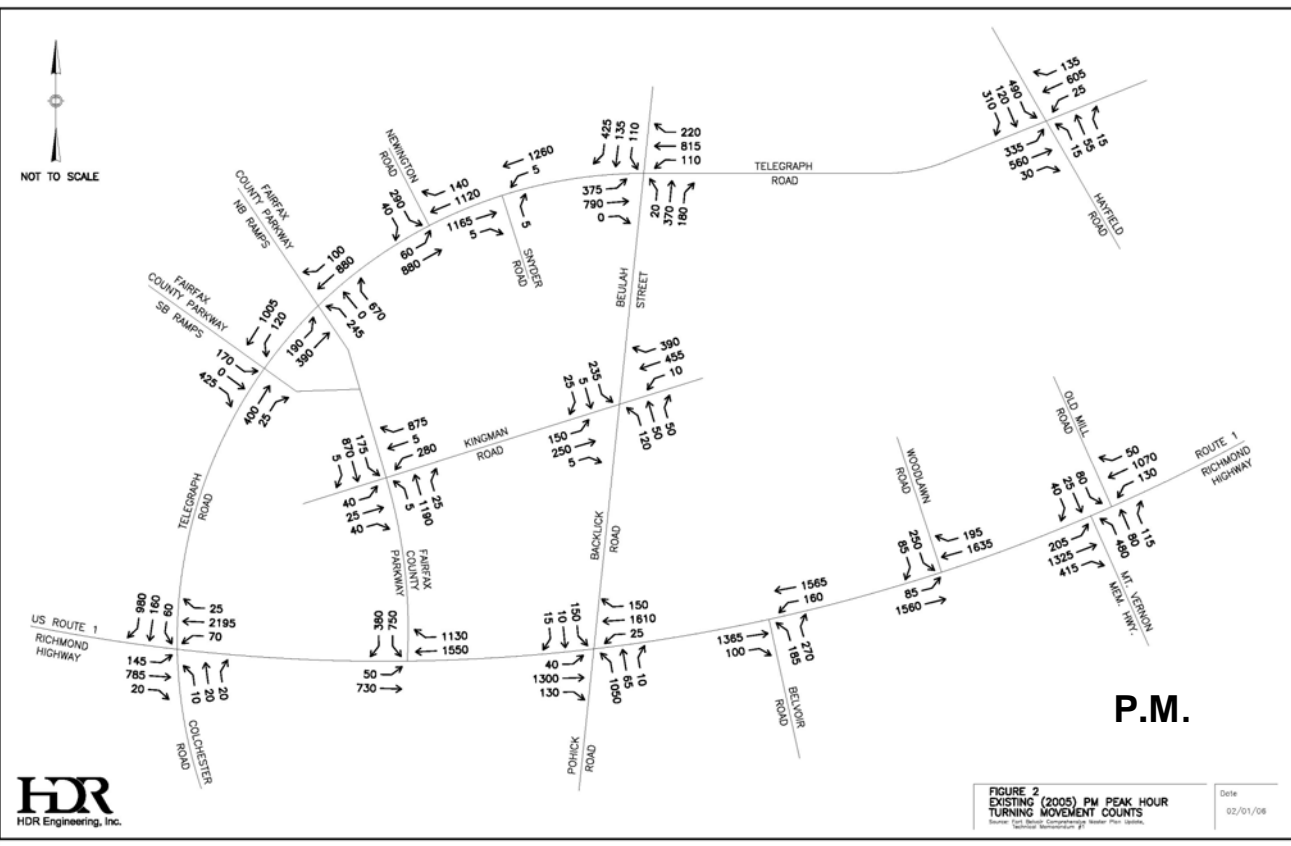


— Census Tract Boundaries
