Did you know that the Morongo Unified School District received \$2 million from a Department of Defense Education Activity grant. The "Challenging Students to Achieve at Higher Levels Grant" will expand learning opportunities for all students in the school district.

In addition to the substantial economic benefits MCAGCC contributes to the Morongo Basin (see story inside), the installation also provides assistance during emergencies.


The Combat Center Fire Department (CCFD) frequently assists the local community Fire Departments in emergencies. In a typical year the CCFD responds to almost 150 mutual aid emergency calls, helping local community fire departments save property and lives. Their assistance in these calls is valued at more than half-a-million dollars.




