New Features

Improve Handling of Critiques with Protected Sections

Internet Assisted Review (IAR), where possible, will temporarily remove any protection for uploaded critiques in order to correctly generate Preliminary Summary Statements and Adobe PDF versions of critiques. The original uploaded critique will not be changed and will remain protected.

Parent Grant Preliminary Summary Statement will include Subproject Abstracts

Preliminary Summary Statements for Parent Grants will include Subproject abstracts, if they exist in the database.

New Warning for COI Pre-Meeting Form

A new warning has been added on the *Submit Critique/Scores* screen in IAR. If the Scientific Review Officer (SRO) enables electronic Conflict of Interest (eCOI) submission, and the reviewer has not signed the pre-meeting COI form, the reviewer will receive a warning when they submit a critique. The warning will read as follows:

Please sign your pre-meeting Conflict of Interest form in IAR system

Office 2007 Files can be Uploaded to Meeting Materials

Users can upload Microsoft Office 2007* files into Meeting Materials. The following files formatted with Microsoft Office 2007* can be uploaded:

- Microsoft Word (.doc, .docx)
- Microsoft Excel (.xls, .xlsx)

^{*}Ability to upload Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) will be included in a future release.




Figure 1: Add New Meeting Materials Screen

Re-enable Delete Final Scores Links and Correct Delete Logic

As of February 2010, it was reported that the **Delete All Final Scores** and **Delete Final Scores** links were not functioning as intended. In response to this issue, the links were removed from the system.

After further research into the issue and changes to coding, the **Delete All Final Scores** and **Delete Final Scores** links are now visible and functioning in IAR. The **Delete All Final Scores** link is located on the *Final Scores* screen. The **Delete Final Scores** link can be found on the *Final Scores Details* screen. See figures below:




Figure 2: The Final Scores Screen—Delete All Final Scores Link




Figure 3: The Final Scores Details Screen—Delete Final Scores

SRO cannot Enter Final Scores for Reviewers during Final Score Phase

IAR will no longer allow SROs to enter final scores, criteria scores or critiques for Reviewers when the Final Scoring Phase is open. This decision was approved by the Review Policy Committee.

All Scores Pop-up Shows Reviewer Role as Conflict

Previously, the *All Scores* pop-up would display a Reviewer's role as Unassigned when that user was in conflict with the corresponding application.

Now, the *All Scores* pop-up will display the user's role as Conflict, if they are in conflict with the application.

Fixes

Applications on All Scores Excel Report do not Display Unassigned Reviewers with Scores

It was previously reported that applications on the *All Scores Excel Report* do not display scores or reviewer names if the reviewer who scored an application is unassigned.

Resolution

This issue has been resolved and the scores from all reviewers will be displayed on the *All Scores Excel Report*.

Final Scores Sweep to Add CF for all Applications Where Reviewer Conflict Exists

It was reported that when an SRO swept the final scores for applications in IAR, the system was not populating the Conflict (CF) non-numerical final score for applications where reviewers are in conflict.

Resolution

This issue has been resolved and applications that reviewers are in conflict with will be given the non-numerical final score of CF.

Final Score Matrix Excel Report Is Not Working

It was reported that when a user clicked the **Final Scores Matrix** link on the *Final Scores* screen, the report was not correctly generated, which resulted in a blank page with a gray line.

Resolution

Now, when a user clicks the **Final Scores Matrix** link, the report will be displayed.
