New Features

Block Discussants Option Added to Control Center

A Center for Scientific Review (CSR) requirement has resulted in the addition of a meeting wide option added to the control center. When set to Yes, the option will block a discussant from reading other reviewers' critiques for assigned applications where they have not submitted their own.

When setting up new meetings in IAR, please note that the default value for this option will be Yes, meaning that discussants will be blocked. Scientific Review Officers (SROs) can set this option to No, and the system will function as it previously had.

NOTE: To avoid disruption to ongoing meetings at the time of release, the new option will be set to No for all upcoming meetings where the Submit phase has already been setup.




Figure 1: Block Discussants Option In Control Center

Download ZIP of All Critiques Option Added to the List of All Applications Screen

SROs and Extramural Scientist Administrators (ESA) can now download a Zip file of all critiques submitted by reviewers per application. The **Download Zip of All Critiques (PDF)** link can be found on the *Simple List of Applications* and *List of All Applications* screens anytime after the Submit Phase End Date. This new option will create a Zip file containing a PDF document for each application. This option will help to alleviate the load of *Preliminary Summary Statement (PSS)* creation by providing another method for easily downloading critiques. SROs are encouraged to use this option instead of creating PSS at the end of the Submit Phase.

The PDF document created for each application contains all critiques submitted for an application (assigned and unassigned) and standard header information including preliminary scores.




Figure 3: Zip File Containing PDF Files Of Critiques

New Warning Message During Final Scoring

To prevent Reviewers' scores from being overwritten during Final Scoring meetings, SRO/ESA no longer have the ability to modify scores during Final Scoring. A warning message will appear indicating that "You cannot update scores at this time. Only reviewers can update scores while Final Scoring is in session." The warning message will display on the following screens:

- Final Scores
- Final Scores Details
- Voter Sheet

Save All Link on Final Scoring Page in Firefox

In an effort to support Reviewers who are using Firefox, the **Save All** link on the *Voter Sheet* page has been enhanced. This link will work for both Internet Explorer and Firefox browsers.

Upload .pptx (MS PowerPoint 2007) Files to Meeting Materials

Previously, when a user attempted to upload a Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 file (*.pptx) to the *Add New Meeting Materials* screen, that user received the following error message:

The file you are attempting to upload is either Open by another application or is of an improper file format. Please check the file to resolve this discrepancy (ID: 20386)

Resolution

A change has been made to fix this issue. *Add New Meeting Materials* now accepts PowerPoint 2007 files (*.pptx).




Figure 4: Add New Meeting Materials Supported File Types
