The Virgin Islands Department of Public Works (VIDPW) and the Federal Highway Administration are seeking public comment on the proposed improvement of Raphune Hill Road (Route 38) and Route 381 in Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas, United States Virgin Islands. The proposed project would improve road conditions of the existing Route 38 by expanding roadway capacity to reduce congestion, flattening curves to increase safety, and constructing a sidewalk to improve pedestrian access. Route 381 would be realigned at its intersection with Route 38 in order to improve safety.
