

PUBLIC SCOPING COMMENT PERIOD OPENS FOR FORT PULAKSI BRIDGE PROJECT

The Fort Pulaski National Monument of the National Park Service, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration, is initiating an Environmental Assessment to analyze the proposed repair or replacement of the Fort Pulaski Bridge over the South Channel of the Savannah River along Fort Pulaski Road (NPS Route 10). The Fort Pulaski Bridge was originally constructed in 1938, and has deteriorated. The Fort Pulaski National Monument is seeking comments on the proposed action and its potential impacts. You are invited to review the background information for the project and submit comments through the park's Planning, Environment, and Public Comment (PEPC) website at <http://parkplanning.nps.gov/>, Fort Pulaski National Monument.
