PAPER OR CARDBOARD

RECYCLE

- newspapers
- white paper
- colored paper
- magazines
- cardboard
- envelopes

DO NOT RECYCLE

- dirty paper
- hygienic paper
- wallpaper
- fast food containers
- compound materials



GLASS AND METAL CANS

RECYCLE

- soda bottles/cans
- beer bottles
- juice bottles/cans
- food jars/cans
- wine/liquor bottles
- drinking glasses

DO NOT RECYCLE

- mirrors
- porcelain
- auto glass
- light bulbs
- metallic wrapping
- dirty aluminum



PLASTIC

RECYCLE

- bags
- bottles
- cups
- wraps/foils
- margarine cups
- potato chip bags

DO NOT RECYCLE

- laminated plastic
- foams
- Styrofoam
- dirty plastics
- plastic cases



HOUSEHOLD CLEANERS

RECYCLE

- oven, glass, and carpet cleaners
- bleach, cleaning spray, and floor wax
- furniture polish and wood preservatives
- disinfectants and cleansers
- toilet bowl cleaner

RECYCLING

It s the Law!

- German environmental laws and Army Regulation 200-1, Separate or Recycle Trash Program require separation and recycling of recyclable materials and special disposal of hazardous waste.

LOCATION OF RECYCLE CONTAINERS

There are recycling islands located in various locations on each installation, to include in single family quarters. Each island has containers marked for paper, glass or metal, plastic and or non recyclables trash.



RECYCLE CENTERS

Each installation has a center for the disposal of large size recyclables.

TYPES OF LARGE RECYCABLES

HOUSEHOLD ELECTRONIC OR METAL SCRAPS

- PC, laptop, TV, radio, dishwasher, microwave, dryer, vacuum cleaner, or electric razor, that are not government property, contain recyclable materials.
- Drop-off at the DPW Yard on Kelley Barracks. Please call DSN 421-6288 to arrange a drop-off time.

WOOD OR BULKY FURNITURE ITEMS

- Bulky items such as a desk, chair, sofa, mattress, or table can be disposed at the recycling centers.
- For the disposal of large quantities of wood or furniture please contact DSN 421-6288 to arrange for pick up.

CARS TIRES AND RIMS

Tires and rims are recycled separately.

Contact the MWR Auto Craft Shop or the Exchange Car Care Center to have the tires separated from the rims.

Dispose old tires in the containers located at the Exchange Car Care Center, MWR Auto Craft Shop on Panzer Kaserne or at the DPW Yard on Kelley Barracks.

Rims are disposed into the metal scrap containers on Panzer Kaserne and at the DPW Yard.

BATTERIES

Dry cell batteries used for radios, cameras, electronic toys, etc., are recyclable garbage.

Dry cell battery collection containers are located at Patch, Panzer, and Kelley Commissaries, Panzer Exchange, Robinson Commissary/Exchange, Patch Gas Station, Kelley Gas Station, Kelley Shoppette, and at various German Stores.

EXPIRED MEDICINES

Expired medicine can be returned to any pharmacy.

CAR BATTERIES AND PAINT

Car batteries filled with sulfuric acid are **recyclable hazardous material.**

Hazardous Waste is the toxic portion of waste and contains hazardous substances that do not go into the regular trash and must be disposed of separately.

Please contact your Recycle Installation Coordinator for proper disposal of hazardous waste.

Containers for car batteries are located at Patch Barracks, Panzer Kaserne, Panzer Auto Craft Shop, Panzer Car Care Center, Kelley Hazardous Waste Storage Area and Robinson Barracks.

PAINT

Some solvent-based paints are hazardous waste and include solvent-based waste paint, empty, partially filled, and full spray paint aerosol cans and must be disposed of separately.

For turn-in at the Hazardous Waste Storage area on Kelley Barracks call the Environmental Office at DSN 421-6134.

Dry residues of latex or water based paints are non hazardous and can be dropped into the regular trash container.

AUTOMOTIVE WASTE

Used oil and oil filters, empty oil cans must be properly disposed of at the Exchange Car Care Center and MWR Auto Craft, on Panzer Kaserne.
