HOW TO DISPOSE OF UNWANTED MEDICATIONS

- **DO** bring any unwanted medications to your Firm Pharmacist for disposal.
- **DO NOT** flush medications. Traces of medication have been found in our water supply.
- **DO NOT** pour medications down a drain. Traces of medication have been found in our water supply.
- **DO NOT** put drugs in the trash without disguising them- human or animal scavengers may find them and misuse them.

Follow these 7 steps to safety when disposing of unwanted medication:

- 1. Keep medications in the original container. This will help identify the contents if they are accidentally ingested.
- 2. Mark out you name, prescription number and other personal information for safety.
- For pills-add some water or soda to start dissolving them; for liquid-add something inedible like cat litter, dirt or cayenne pepper.
- 4. Close the lid and secure with duct or packing tape.
- Place the bottle(s) inside an opaque (non see-through) container like a coffee can or plastic laundry bottle.
- 6. Tape that container closed.
- 7. Hide the container in the trash. DO NOT put in the recycle bin.
