The staff of the VA Medical Center in Washington, DC (DCVAMC) is committed to serving the unique needs of women Veterans. This commitment is reflected in our outstanding quality health care and in our determination to provide care in an environment that fosters respect and courtesy.

DCVAMC offers a dedicated Women's Health Clinic operated by experienced clinicians who understand the needs of women. The Medical Center employs a full-time Women Veterans Program Manager who personally oversees the Women Veterans Program and the Women's Health Clinic.

Saturday clinic hours are offered to accommodate your schedule. For those with children, we've installed baby changing stations throughout the Medical Center and have some activities available to keep your children entertained during your visit. If you require child care, arrangements can be made with advance notice with La Petite Academy, located on our campus. *Phone 202-986-5738 for more information.*

At DCVAMC, we focus on delivering great health care, but also with helping you to maintain good health and prevent disease. DCVAMC's program for women gives comprehensive primary care in a setting specifically for women Veterans. We can arrange for a single provider to take care of both your primary care and your gender specific needs, in a private setting designed for women.

If you've already established a relationship with one of our general Primary Care Providers, you can continue under their care and receive your gender specific care (PAP smears, STD screens, contraception, hormone replacement, etc.) in the Women's Health Clinic or at our Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs).
