MEMORANDUM FOR ALL US Army Garrison Camp Parks Personnel

SUBJECT: Camp Parks Policy #33, Smoking Policy

1. REFERENCE:

AR 600-63, Army Health Promotion, 7 May 2007/ RAR 20 September 2009.

2. PURPOSE: To provide guidance to civilian and military personnel assigned to or under the command of the Camp Parks Commander regarding smoking on the installation.

3. APPLICABILITY: These procedures are applicable to civilian and military personnel assigned to and under the operational control of the Camp Parks Commander.

4. POLICY: Smoking is prohibited in all buildings on Camp Parks with exception of buildings conforming to AR 600-63 (family housing, unaccompanied housing personnel housing, lodging operations). Smoking will be allowed in designated outdoor smoking areas only. Outdoor designated smoking areas will be established using the following guidance:

a. If possible, designated smoking areas will provide a reasonable measure of protection from elements.

b. Designated smoking areas will be a minimum of 50 feet from:

(1) Building Entrances/ Exits.

(2) Vehicles (Fire and Safety).

(3) Areas commonly used by non-smokers (example; outside a window of a building).

c. Clearly marked as a "Designated Smoking Area".

d. Building coordinators are responsible for the establishment of designated smoking areas.

e. Smoking is prohibited in all government vehicles (Military and GSA).

5. All organizational elements that occupy space in or on conveyances, offices, buildings, or facilities at Camp Parks will comply with the Army Policy and guidance.
