MEMORANDUM FOR ALL Parks Reserve Forces Training Area Personnel

SUBJECT: PRFTA Policy #38, Feeding of Wild or Feral Animals

1. REFERENCES:

- a. DOD Directive 4715.1E, Environmental Security, 15 March 2005.
- b. DOD Instruction 4150.07, DoD Pest Management Program, 29 May 2008.
- c. Army Regulation 40-5, Preventative Medicine, 25 May 2007.

2. PURPOSE. To provide guidance to Civilian and military personnel assigned to or under the command of the Parks Reserve Forces Training Area (PRFTA) Commander regarding the feeding of Wild or Feral Animals.

3. APPLICABILITY. These procedures are applicable to Civilian and military personnel assigned to and under the operational control of the PRFTA Commander.


4. POLICY. Department of Defense Directive 4715.1 sets policy for the protection of personnel from disease and property from damage. This memorandum clarifies and expands on policy set forth in the above references.

a. No wild animals are to be fed in the cantonment area of PRFTA.

b. If food is found outside of a building, the building manager will be contacted and directed to remove the food source.

5. If a feral or pest animal is found, contact the Camp Parks Installation Pest Management Coordinator, at (925) 875-4685.

6. PROPONENT. The proponent for this policy is the Director of Public Works office at (925) 875-4638.
