

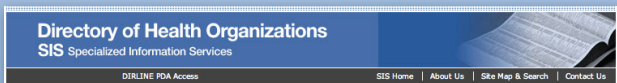

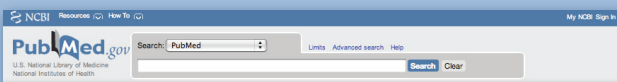

An online directory of more than 8,500 health-related organizations offering information and referral for many diseases and conditions.

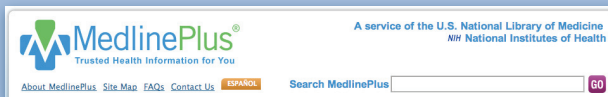

Reliable consumer health information related to HIV/AIDS, opportunistic infections, and living with HIV/AIDS.

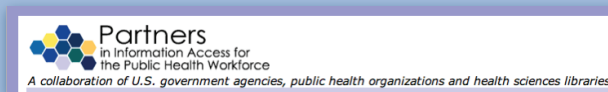

Provides the latest federally approved treatment guidelines for health care professionals as well as additional information on treatment, prevention, and research for both health care providers and consumers.

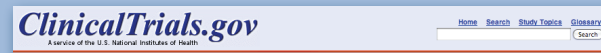

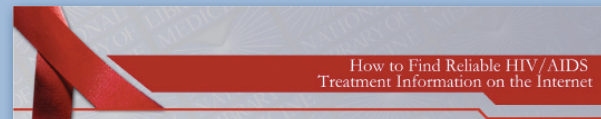
