

#### **DPAS Rated Products**

- About half of U.S. Federal Market Division orders have DPAS ratings
  - Cell phones
  - Pagers
  - Two-way radios
  - Parts and accessories
- Almost all of Systems Solutions Group contracts are DPAS rated
  - Surveillance and Situational awareness systems
  - Secure communications products
  - Tactical radios, Tactical Operations Centers
  - Spacecraft communications and payload modules
  - Target Detecting Devices

- Linkage between DPAS and FAR Regulations

#### Linkage between DPAS and FAR Regulations

- DPAS and FAR are both derived from statutes
- FAR Part 11.6 covers priorities and allocations but does not specifically discuss or provide guidance to Contracting Officers on the applicability of DPAS to commercial items.
- FAR Part 12 exclusively addresses Commercial Item acquisition
  - » 52.212-4 Terms and Conditions Commercial Items and 52.212-5 Terms and Conditions Required to Implement Statutes and Executive Orders do not mention/reference DPAS.
  - » 52.244-6 Subcontracts for Commercial Items and Commercial Components - exempts subcontracts at all levels from all but three EEO FAR clauses - implies an exemption from DPAS.

- Linkage between DPAS and FAR Regulations (continued)
  - FAR Part 13 Simplified Acquisition (including commercial items up to \$5M)
    - » Part 13 does not discuss the application of DPAS to simplified acquisitions. Absence of a reference to DPAS implies it is not applicable.
    - » 52.213-4 Terms and Conditions Simplified Acquisition (Other than Commercial Items) does not reference or contain the DPAS clause. Absence implies not applicable.
