

The Storm Prediction Center (SPC) and the OU School of Meteorology (SoM) are pleased to announce an unpaid "for credit" internship program for the Spring 2013 semester. The objective of the program is to provide the student with a semester-long experience to focus their career goals and provide an opportunity to apply meteorological principles in an operational forecast and research setting. The program is open to second semester juniors, seniors, and first year graduate students who have strong interests in severe weather forecasting and related research topics.

Selected students will spend between 8-10 hrs per week at the SPC working on a research project related to U.S. severe weather events, culminating in a term paper from the student. Three (3) credit hours in **METR 3890** will be earned through this program. The student will also have the opportunity to spend time in the SPC operations area to interact with forecasters and learn about the SPC severe weather forecast process.

With the co-location of the SPC and the SoM in the NWC building, this is a great opportunity!
