

SUBJECT: Activation of Air Force Cyberspace Command (Provisional) (AFCYBER (P))

Effective 18 September 2007, the Air Force will activate AFCYBER (P) with a preliminary location at Barksdale AFB, LA. The provisional MAJCOM will implement HQ USAF coordinated and CSAF-approved field-level implementation actions needed to stand up the follow-on permanent MAJCOM. Following HQ USAF guidance, AFCYBER (P) will develop and coordinate for CSAF approval a permanent MAJCOM implementation program plan and begin building the FY 2010 Program Objective Memorandum to establish the permanent MAJCOM on 1 October 2008. AFCYBER (P) is a temporary unit that will not have any manpower authorizations and will inactivate upon activation of the permanent MAJCOM. The unit designation of the permanent MAJCOM will be determined later. The permanent location will be determined in accordance with AFI 10-503, *Base Unit Beddown Program* and the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

By 18 September 2007, Eighth Air Force will provide 18 personnel, the Air Force Communications Agency will provide 86 personnel and the AFC2ISR Center will provide 55 personnel to be attached to HQ AFCYBER (P) to form the initial headquarters staff. Unless specifically required on-site, these personnel will remain at their primary duty locations. The aforementioned units will provide any necessary support and office space. HQ USAF and ACC will provide appropriate support to AFCYBER (P)/CC to accomplish the assigned mission. TDY support is authorized IAW Air Force directives. If additional personnel are required to support the provisional headquarters staff the AFCYBER (P)/CC will submit a request to the VCSAF. The AFCYBER (P)/CC will submit funding requirements for HQ AFCYBER (P) to SAF/FM.

Please provide HQ AFCYBER (P) your full support as we move forward in building the new MAJCOM to meet the challenges of the cyberspace environment.
