GAO STUDY. 2 (a) STUDY REQUIRED.—The Comptroller General 3 shall carry out a study to examine— (1) the probable impact of the creation of a 4 5 statutory license for the performance of a sound re-6 cording by a terrestrial broadcast station on— 7 (A) local communities for which broadcast 8 radio is licensed to serve; 9 (B) radio broadcasters and their stations; 10 and 11 (C) artists and the recorded music indus-12 try; and 13 (2) the value of promotion to the recording in-14 dustry and artists from free radio airplay of sound 15 recordings and the value to the radio industry from 16 the use of such sound recordings. 17 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 6 months after the date

18 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall

- 1 issue a report to the Congress detailing the findings and
- 2 conclusions made by the Comptroller General in carrying
- 3 out the study required by subsection (a).
