- To ensure all Marines and Sailors of I MEF Situation. Headquarters Group (I MHG), its Major Subordinate Elements (MSEs), and I MEF Command Element (CE) understand the misuse and abuse of Garrison Mobile Equipment (GME)/Government Owned Vehicle (GOV) provided by Marine Corps Installations West (MCIWEST) will not be tolerated.
  - To enforce regulations, maintain individual and command accountability, and defeat a growing trend of speeding and misuse of GME/GOV in order to protect our Marines and Sailors while maintaining operational readiness.

## Commander's Intent and Concept of Operations

### (1) Commander's Intent

(a) Purpose. To ensure the Marines and Sailors of I MHG, its MSEs, and I MEF CE practice the tenets of Operational Risk Management (ORM) prior to, and while operating a GME/GOV. Further, all Marines and Sailors, regardless of rank, adhere to the posted speed limits on and off MCB Camp Pendleton when

operating GME/GOV and understand the ramifications if caught speeding.

- (b) <u>Method</u>. All SNCO's and Officers will ensure the Marines and Sailors under their charge are thoroughly familiar with the guidance set forth by this policy. Further, they will ensure their Marines and Sailors are given the appropriate amount of time to arrive at their destination while adhering to all posted speed limits signs when operating a GME/GOV.
- (c) <u>Endstate</u>. Safeguard lives, prevent the needless loss of resources brought about by unsafe driving practices, and eliminate the amount of speeding violations incurred by the Marines and Sailors of the I MEF CE, I MHG and its MSEs.
- (2) <u>Concept of Operations</u>. I MHG, I MEF CE, and its MSE leadership will enforce the provisions of references (a) and (b), and support compliance with federal and state traffic laws. Key billet holders will assign only trustworthy vehicle operators and enforce the safe operation of government vehicles.
- (a) Violations incurred by I MHG Marines will be processed by their respective company office (Headquarters Company or Military Police Company).
- (b) Violations incurred by I MEF CE Marines will be processed by the I MHG Headquarters Company Office.
- (c) Violations incurred by MSE Marines will be processed by the respective Bn Cdr. The MSE S-4 will be notified by the I MHG S-4 of the violation and will back brief the I MHG S-4 and I MHG Sergeant Major on who the violator was and when appropriate action has been taken.

#### b. Tasks

#### (1) I MHG S-4

(a): Post the warning sign depicted in Enclosure (1) on the dashboard of all I MHG/I MEF CE GME/GOV.

#### (2) MSE S-4s

(a) Post the warning sign depicted in Enclosure (1) on the dashboard of all  ${\tt GME/GOV}$ .

## c. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) All personnel using GME/GOV and their leadership will be familiar with this policy and with the individual penalties listed in Enclosure (2) and the unit penalties listed in Enclosure (3).
- (2) All personnel using GME/GOV will follow the checkout/inspection procedures delineated in Enclosure (4).
- 4. Administration and Logistics. This policy becomes effective on the date signed and applies to I MHG, its MSEs, and I MEF CE.
- 5. <u>Command and Signal</u>. The I MHG Executive Officer, I MHG Sergeant Major and the I MHG S-4 Officer will oversee adherence to this policy.

The table below identifies potential actions the CG MCIWEST may take against MHG if there is a trend in GME violations.

Enclosure (4) I MHG Vehicle Check Out Procedures

These procedures apply to all Marines and Sailors regardless of rank.

- 1. All Garrison Mobile Equipment will be checked out from the I MHG S-4 shop. Phone: 760-725-6334.
- 2. When checking out Garrison Mobile Equipment (GME), the driver must fill out a I MHG Vehicle Inspection Form, GME Policy for Vehicle Operation, and a Vehicle Check-out Checklist. The top portion of the I MHG Vehicle Inspection Form will be filled out prior to check-out. Blank forms are kept at the MHG S-4 and are provided as Enclosure (5) for information.
- 3. The Marine checking out the vehicle is the only authorized driver for the vehicle and will be held solely accountable for any incidents with the vehicle while it is checked out under his/her name.
- 4. Once the form has been completed, the driver will sign out the vehicle in the "GME Vehicle Checkout Logbook". Required information to check out a vehicle:
  - a. Date Date vehicle checked out
  - b. Section Driver's section
  - c. Vehicle # GME identification number / plate number
  - d. Name Name of driver
  - e. Phone # Driver's contact phone number
- 5. If a fuel key is needed, it will be checked out on a separate line in the GME Vehicle Checkout Logbook.
- 6. The driver will only be able to take the vehicle once all actions delineated in the paragraphs above are completed.
- 7. If the vehicle is damaged at any time, the driver must notify S-4 personnel immediately and fill out an SF-91 Motor Vehicle Accident Report form. This form will be verified and signed by the S-4 Chief or his delegated representative before the form and vehicle are turned in to Base Motors for repairs. If the driver is found negligent, punitive action will be taken.
- 8. Most GME assets are equipped with GPS and DriveCams. Vehicles equipped with these devices are constantly monitored by Enclosure (4) I MHG Vehicle Check Out Procedures

South West Regional Fleet Transportation (SWRFT). If the driver is found speeding or driving recklessly, punitive action will be taken in accordance with Enclosures (2) and (3).

- 9. When the vehicle is returned, the driver must fill out the "Check in Vehicle Inspection" portion of the Vehicle Inspection Form with S-4 personnel present. S-4 personnel will check the vehicle for damage, cleanliness, and will ensure that that the fuel level is at least % full and that the radio is turned down or off.
- 10. Once the vehicle has been inspected by S-4 personnel, the driver may log the vehicle back into the GME Vehicle Checkout Logbook. The columns to be filled out are:
  - a. Date Received (Date vehicle was returned)
- b. Received by (S-4 representative who received / inspected the vehicle)
- 11. The driver will not be released by the S-4 representative until all actions delineated in paragraphs seven through ten above are completed.
- 12. Completed I MHG Vehicle Inspection Forms will be kept on file in the S-4 for one year.

### Enclosure (5) Check Out/In Forms

### GME POLICY FOR VEHICLE OPERATION

- 1. Vehicles will be operated at or below the POSTED speed limits in all areas of operation. This means that you do not drive with the flow of traffic.
- 2. Vehicles are not authorized at fast food establishments, exchanges, commissaries, housing areas or for any personal use.
- 3. Seat belts will be worn by the driver and all occupants of the vehicle while the vehicle is in motion.
- 4. The van is equipped with a Drive Cam and GPS tracking system. The camera records where you are going and activities that happen in the cab of the vehicle. The GPS tracking system transmits the position and the speed of the vehicle in timed intervals. This means that if you are speeding a report is transmitted to South West Region Fleet Transportation and then forwarded to this office for review. Speeding violations are adjudicated as appropriate via the chain of command. The Drive Cam is equipped with a red panic button that is located on the bottom of the camera. This button is to be used if during operation a driver of another vehicle is driving in a "road rage" manner. Push the button and the camera will start to record the "road rage" vehicle's actions.
