This packet is for your use and information in entering your selected piece of artwork for this competition. Please read carefully. In order for your art to be accepted, it must comply with the enclosed guidelines and specifications.

All qualified entries will be on view from Saturday, April 13 through Sunday, May 5 at The Dayton Art Institute. The grand-prize winner and runners-up will be announced and each participant honored with a Certificate of Special Congressional Recognition from Congressman Mike Turner. This special award ceremony will take place on Sunday, May 5 at 1:00 p.m. at The Dayton Art Institute. You and your family are invited to this event.

Scholarships may be provided to the first, second and third place finishers. Depending on the first place winner's choice, there may be either one or two remaining scholarships, as only the competition winner is eligible for the Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) scholarship. The second and third place winners may choose from the remaining scholarships. Competition winners' decisions must be declared to Marty Heide, in Congressman Mike Turner's Office, within one month of the conclusion of the contest.

If there are scholarships unclaimed, they may be offered through a lottery selection to those students who received an honorable mention. More detailed scholarship information will be provided in a follow-up letter.

- This competition is open to high school *Juniors and Seniors ONLY* (grades 11 and 12).
- The student **must** attend a high school located within the 10<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.
- Artwork is limited to one (1) entry per student.
- Artwork **must** be two-dimensional.
- The artwork <u>must</u> be matted and hang-ready (it can be matted or framed for display purposes if desired).
- The hang-ready artwork must not exceed framed dimensions of *24"wide x 24"high x 4"deep*
- Size of the artwork must allow for potential framing if chosen as the grand prizewinner.
- All artwork <u>must</u> be delivered/picked up by the teacher only at:

Congressman Turner's district office can also provide assistance with the drop off/pick up of artwork. For information, contact Marty Heide in Congressman Turner's office at (937) 225-2843.

Each piece of artwork must be accompanied by two (2) completed *Student Information/Release Forms*. One of these forms must be taped to the back of the artwork.

#### **General Information Continued**

Artwork must be within the following categories:

- Painting (oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.)
- Drawing (pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers, etc.)
- Collage (must be two-dimensional)
- Print (lithograph, silk screen, block prints)
- Photography
- Computer Generated Art
- Mixed Media (any combination of the above )

Entry must be an original concept; the entry *may not* reproduce an image from a third party's work in the same or other medium.

The work may not violate the U.S. Copyright Laws.

**Note:** Any entry which has been reproduced from an existing photo, painting or any other work is in violation of the competition rules and will not be accepted. Final decision regarding suitability for exhibition in the Capitol shall be at the discretion of a panel of qualified persons chaired by the Architect of the Capitol.

Prizes and participation certificates will be given at the Award Ceremony and Reception on **Sunday, May 5<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 p.m.** at The Dayton Art Institute. Teachers, students, and their families are invited to attend.

Scholarships may be provided to the first, second and third place finishers. Depending on the first place winner's choice, there may be either one or two remaining scholarships, as only the competition winner is eligible for the Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD) scholarship. The second and third place winners may choose from the remaining scholarships. Competition winners' decisions must be declared to Marty Heide, in Congressman Mike Turner's Office, within one month of the conclusion of the contest.

If there are scholarships unclaimed, they may be offered through a lottery selection to those students who received an honorable mention. More detailed scholarship information will be provided in a follow-up letter.

- □ I am submitting no more than one (1) entry.

#### My entry is:

- □ Two-dimensional.
- □ Matted and hang-ready.
- □ No larger than 24"wide, x 24"high and 4" deep.
- □ In one of following categories:
  - Painting (oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.)
  - Drawing (pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers, etc.)
  - Collage (must be two-dimensional)
  - Print (lithograph, silk screen, block prints)
  - Photography
  - Computer Generated Art
  - Mixed Media (mixture of any of the above categories)
- □ My entry is an original concept, design and execution. It does not reproduce an image from a third party's work in the same or other medium.
- □ My work does not violate U.S. Copyright Laws.
