

**2001 IFQ/CDQ Halibut and Sablefish Allocations  
January 29, 2001**

The following tables show amounts of Pacific halibut and sablefish available for the 2001 Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) and Community Development Quota (CDQ) fisheries. Halibut amounts were adopted by the International Pacific Halibut Commission on January 25, 2001, and reflect the catch sharing plan implemented by the North Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council); final allocations of sablefish were published in the Federal Register (66 FR 7276, January 22, 2001).
