The following tables show amounts of Pacific halibut and sablefish available for the 2004 Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) and Community Development Quota (CDQ) fisheries. Halibut amounts were adopted by the International Pacific Halibut Commission on January 23, 2004, and reflect the catch sharing plan implemented by the North Pacific Fishery Management Council.
