

<b>Sablefish</b>	1% of SE IFQ TAC	5,687,868 round pounds	56,879 round pounds
	1% of All IFQ TAC	24,876,707 round pounds	248,767 round pounds

**Note:** Vessel IFQ Caps are calculated on the IFQ TAC only; CDQ TACs are not included in the calculations.

- QSP = Quota Share Pool or Pools; IFQ = Individual Fishing Quota; TAC = Total Allowable Catch.
- Halibut weights are expressed in net (headed and gutted) pounds, and sablefish weights are expressed in round pounds.
