The following tables show amounts of Pacific halibut and sablefish available for the 2011 Individual Fishing Quota (IFQ) and Community Development Quota (CDQ) fisheries. Halibut amounts, adopted by the International Pacific Halibut Commission at its January 2011 meeting, reflect the catch sharing plan implemented by the North Pacific Fishery Management Council.
