## TRANSPARENCY RECYCLING

Don't throw out your used overhead transparencies!  
**RECYCLE** them for **REUSE**. It's Easy!

### Follow these simple procedures:

- 1.) **COLLECT** used transparencies to be recycled.
- 2.) **SEPARATE** the transparencies from ringed binders, plastic or paper folders, envelopes, and/or files.
- 3.) **PLACE** the transparencies (only) into an intra-laboratory mail envelope.
- 4.) **SEND** the envelope to:
