On 22 Jul 11, the President, Secretary of Defense, and Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff certified to Congress that the military is prepared to accept openly gay, lesbian, and bisexual service members, and that doing so will not harm military readiness. Following that certification, the policy known as DADT was repealed effective **20 Sep 11**.

- (1) <u>DADT</u>. The Sustainment Phase of the Repeal of DADT began on **20 Sep 11**. At this time, Homosexual Conduct Policy Training and the tiered DADT Repeal training products are discontinued and not replaced. Sustainment training consists of updated annual SHARP training and annual Army Values training available on the Army Training Network at <a href="https://atn.army.mil/">https://atn.army.mil/</a>. Schools and Centers will emphasize treatment of Soldiers with dignity and respect in the current leader and values training.
- (a) All MSOs and CoEs. Begin using updated schools' programs of instruction for Professional Military Education, Initial Military Training, Pre-Commissioning Education and Functional Training that are consistent with the revised Army policy and will reinforce the value of respect to all.
- (b) <u>CAC</u>. As the TRADOC proponent for Army Core Values, complete the exportable training support package for Army Values training as part of an annual training requirement in operational units. This training will be a one hour block of instruction designed to be taught annually within all units in the operational force. Place the Army Values training support products on the Army Training Network site (<a href="https://atn.army.mil/">https://atn.army.mil/</a>) NLT 30 Sep 11, so that operational Army units may access this training material to conduct annual sustainment training. Ensure Army Values training is sexual orientation neutral and emphasizes respect to all Soldiers regardless of their sexual orientation.
- (c) <u>DCG, IMT</u>. Begin using updated SHARP Initial Entry Training programs of instruction and updated Army Values training for Initial Military Training.
