

## Arizona – Federal Lands Access Program - Project Selection Criteria

<b>Criteria 1: Access, Mobility, and Connectivity</b>
a. Provides access for high use FLMA recreational site(s)
b. Improves/provides facilities for alternative modes
c. Enhances FLMA visitor experience
d. Reduces congestion
e. Connects to additional routes serving FLMAs
<b>Criteria 2: Economic Development</b>
a. Enhances access and connectivity to local communities
b. Provides access to Federal economic generator
<b>Criteria 3: Condition</b>
a. Improves condition of bridge structures
b. Improves pavement condition
c. Reduces maintenance or operating costs
<b>Criteria 4: Safety</b>
a. Improves safety for a wide range of users
b. Mitigates a known safety issue/reduces crashes
<b>Criteria 5: Funding, Coordination and Cost</b>
a. Partnerships and funding from other sources
b. Project has been coordinated with FLMA
c. Project is in applicable state, regional, FLMA, or local plans
d. Cost effectiveness
e. Sustainability of proposed project budget and financial plan
<b>Criteria 6: Natural Resource Protection</b>
a. Protects or restores natural, cultural and historical resources
b. Enhances wildlife connectivity, and habitats
c. Reduces pollution (noise, emissions)
